For Beginners to Advanced

In this workshop students will work from instructor handouts. Stan will demonstrate and then students will attempt to do what the instructor has done, starting with very simple techniques to more advanced portrait techniques. Stan will visit each student as they paint. Technique, color, composition and design will be addressed. Students should also bring a few photos of animals they would like to paint. Stan Miller is a member of the American Watercolor Society as well as an award winner with AWS. He has won two national first place awards in the last three years. Stan will demonstrate Saturday and Sunday morning. The fundamentals of good painting will be discussed and demonstrated. Students who already have their own supplies need not purchase new supplies. Students who don't have supplies or want to try watercolor for the first time should note the Stan Miller supply list. All students should come ready to paint.

SUPPLIES FOR CLASS:

Photos of animals you want to paint.

Watercolor Paper - Arches 140-lb. cold press. two ½ sheets minimum.

Brushes - 1" flat watercolor brush, synthetic or natural bristle. I also recommend a 1/2" flat brush - medium sized (# 8-15) round and a small round (# 5-7). Bring what you have.

Watercolor Palette with a fairly large mixing area. (I use the John Pike Palette)

Watercolor paints a strong red, yellow and blue. Bring colors you have if fresh.

Water container - Should be able to hold at least a pint of water.

Sponge: An inexpensive grocery store sponge. - **Viva Paper towels.** - **Masking tape Pencil and eraser** (suggest kneaded eraser) **sketch paper or scrap watercolor paper** Optional - **Watercolor Board** no bigger than 24" x 30"
